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45 year old male presented with history of Diabetes Mellitus for the last 10 years with all complications. He had proteinuria and microscopic hematuria for which he underwent renal biopsy.

Renal Biopsy showed typical features of Diabetic Nephropathy. A. Hyaline drops B. Fibrin Caps and C: Kimmelstiel Wilson nodules.

In a study of 83 patient with biopsy proven diabetic nephropathy, 36 (43%) had microscopic hematuria that was associated with presence of more marked arteriolar hyalinosis.
