ANSWER

Oteonecrolysis or Acro-osteolysis [resorption] of the terminal phalanges due to tertiary hyperparathyroidism. Other differential diagnosis of terminal phalanges resorption include, Scleroderma, Raunauds disease, psoriatic arthritis, frostbite, peripheral vascular disease, polyvinyl chloride exposure and Hajdu-Cheney syndrome.
