

Nephrotic & Hypercoagulable State

Image in Nephrology

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38 year old male presented with swelling and frothy urine. He had massive proteinuria of 16 grams, and serum albumin of 1.2 g/dl, later diagnosed as a case of Membranous GN. Presented to emergency with pain and weakness of right foot. The image (arrows) shows the ischemic foot due to arterial thrombosis of posterior tibial artery on doppler ultrasound. He was anticoagulated with resolution of ischemia.
